Best Times:

Salmon - 1st July - 31st August
Brown Trout - 1st April - 20th October
Sea Trout - 1st July - 31st August

Methods:

Fly, spinning and bait (worm)

Best Salmon Flies:

Shrimp patterns sized 8-10, red, gold and silver shrimp, wye bug, general practitioner, wilkinsons shrimp.

Best Sea Trout Flies:

Watsons fancy, teal blue & silver and black pennell

Best Brown Trout Flies:

Hen fly, lazy brown, peter ross, delphi silver, dry olives and sedges
