Best Salmon Flies:

Gold shrimp, cascade, bann special, appachie, wye bug, silver wilkinson

Best Sea Trout Flies:

Black pennell, butcher, bloody butcher, watsons fancy, peter ross, teal, blue silver

Equipment:

10-12 foot rod best suited. Also, body waders as river is best fished in spate conditions.
