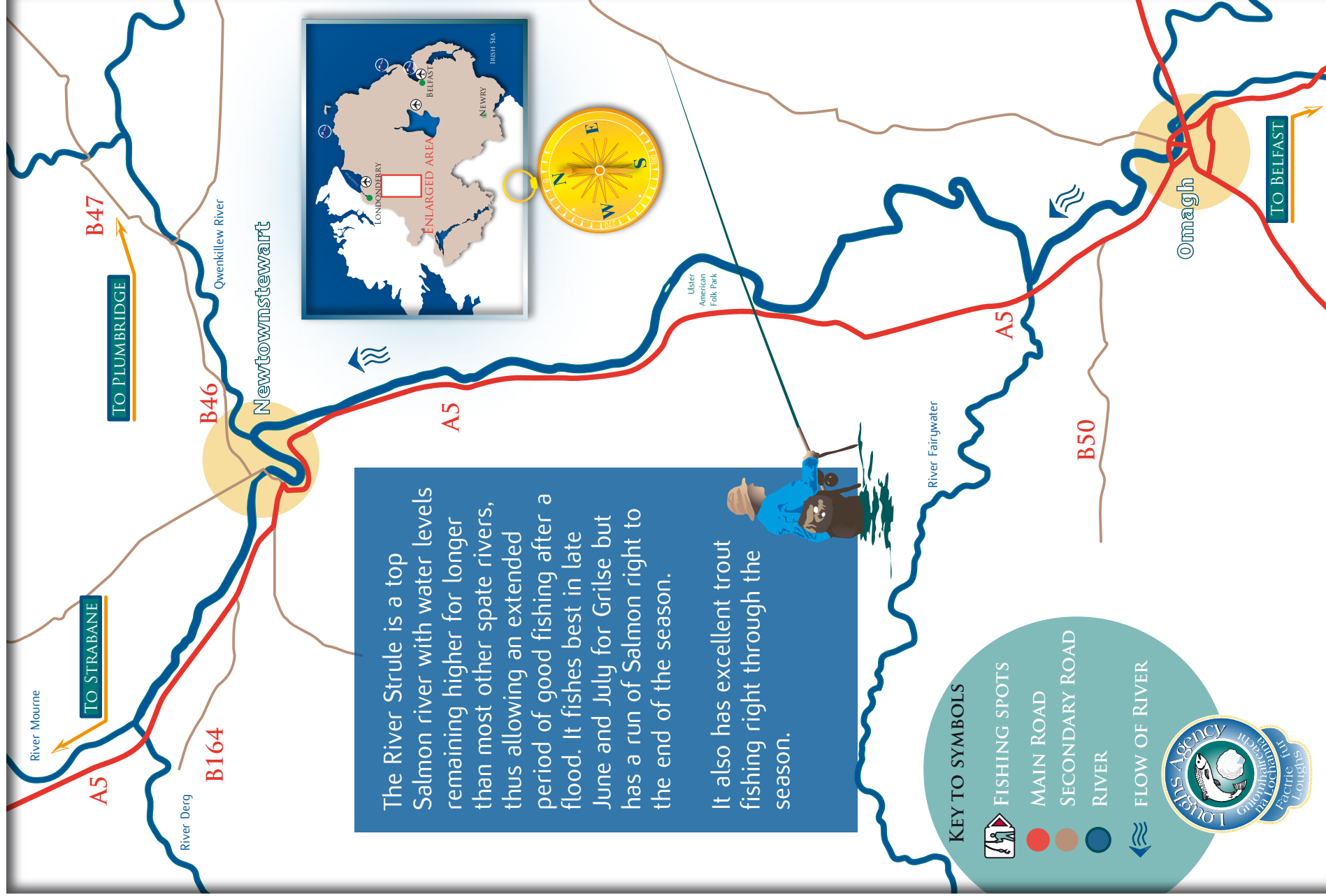


# RIVER STRULE



## SEASON:

1st April to 20th October

## PERMIT REQUIRED:

## SPECIES:

Salmon, brown trout and occasional sea trout

## BEST TIMES:

Salmon: 15th June – end September;

Brown Trout: 1st April – 20th October.

## METHODS:

Fly-fishing, spinning and worming.

## BEST SALMON FLIES:

Shrimp patterns such as Curry's Red, Curry's Gold, Bann Special, Hairy Mary, Stoats Tail.

## BEST TROUT FLIES:

Nymphs and dry flies to imitate olives, sedges and midges. Pheasant Tail Nymph, Hare's Ear, Gold Head Hare's Ear, CDC Emergers, Peter Ross, Delphi Silver, Dry Olives and Sedges,
